(PUBLIC FOOTPATH 6 – 6 – 15 GRIMSARGH, PRESTON CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit temporarily any pedestrian from proceeding over Public Footpath 6 – 6 – 15 Grimsargh, Preston, indicated below:-

That part of Public Footpath 6 – 6 – 15 Grimsargh, Preston, from Preston Road, Grimsargh at Point A (SD 5927 – 3458) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 400 metres to Point B (SD 5902 – 3489) at the junction with Public Footpath 6 – 6 -14 Grimsargh.

The closure is necessary whilst works are carried out on or near the footpath.

Access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the footpath, will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the order shall apply to emergency service vehicles or to those undertaking the works

The Order will be operative from the 17th September, 2018, for a period of 6 months or until the works are completed within this period.

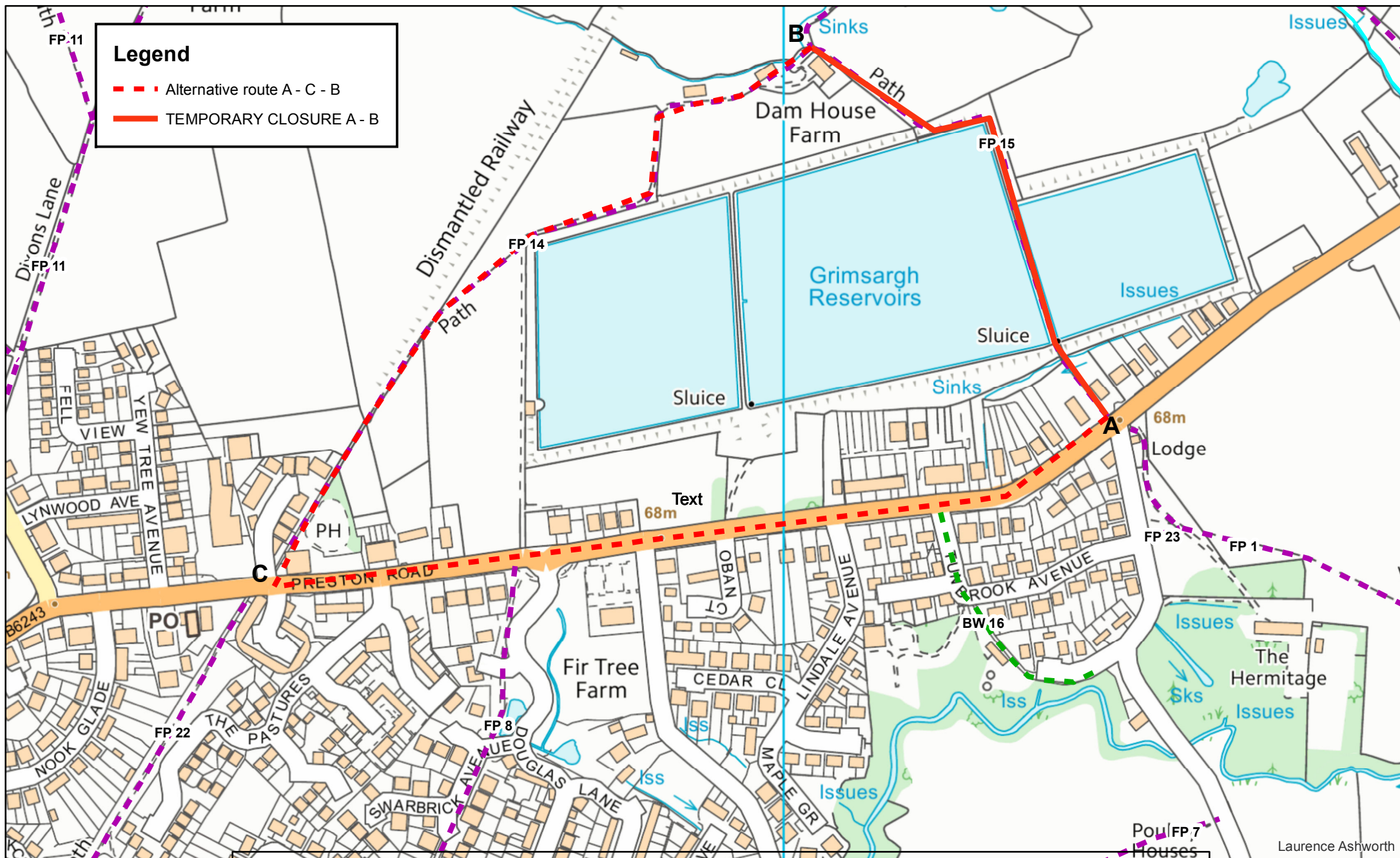
